1. Essential Documents

- Layering clothes (useful for temperature changes)
- Swimsuit (in case your hotel has a pool or spa)

3. Hygiene Products

- Toiletry bag (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant)
- Shampoo and body wash (travel-size)
- Personal medications

- Sunscreen (if applicable)
- Face mask and hand sanitizer
- Wet wipes
- Hairbrush, hair clips, etc...

4. Accessories

- Backpack or day bag
- Power adapter (French plugs)
- Chargers for your electronic devices
- Glasses or sunglasses
- Book or travel guide

- Small wallet with change (handy for markets or vending machines)
